Citizens of Palm Valley,

Early voting begins Monday, April 24. I would like to remind everyone that we have a Special Election item on the ballot. The proposition on the ballot is to adopt a local Sale and Use tax increase of one percent (1%). This adoption will raise our Sales and Use Tax from 7.25% to 8.25%. The revenue that will be generated from this increase will allow us to start a fund that we can build on which will be eventually used to improve our City's infrastructure.

I encourage everyone to make time and vote. Every vote matters.
