- 1. **CALL TO ORDER** The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Hoff.
- PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE The Pledge of Allegiance followed led by Mayor Pro Tem Hoff.
- 3. LEGISLATIVE PRAYER The Legislative Prayer was recited by Councilman Wade.
- 4. **PUBLIC COMMENTS** None
- 5. PAYMENT APPROVED FOR MITIGATION COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH LAKE NO. 3 DRAINAGE PROJECT

David Flinn explained that the costs were for:

Compost \$ 592.81 Hydro Mulch \$4,800.00 Installation of sprinkler system \$12,100.00

In order to improve the drainage, Club property was damaged, and it is necessary to put back the pond as it was. The sprinkler system will be placed around the pond where the wall was installed.

The payment will be coming out of the project's budget from money that was not spent.

Councilwoman Taylor made a motion to approve the payment for a total amount of \$17,492.81.

Councilman Lucio seconded the motion.

Mayor Pro Tem Hoff took the votes and the motion carried unanimously by those present.
